<u>Deposit of Items for Re-Sale</u> <u>Conditions of Acceptance of Second-hand Goods for Sale</u>

Second-hand items are only accepted for resale at the discretion of the Clothing Pool management. Acceptance is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Goods will be held on behalf of the owner for 2 years. After that time they will automatically be disposed of at the discretion of the Clothing Pool.
- 2. Commission is charged at 25% which is donated to the Parents' and Friends' Association.
- 3. Goods shall be current uniform items and in good order, that is: free from tears, patches, stains etc or obvious wear.
- 4. All items should be ready to wear by their next owner: <u>Blazers must be dry cleaned with dry cleaning tape attached</u>. All clothing shall be freshly laundered and ironed. Name tape removed, seams and hems sewn, buttons secured and any other details attended to.
- 5. Bags, boots and equipment shall be clean.

- 7. The Clothing Pool Managers cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage occurring to articles left for sale. Every care will be taken.
