Deposit of Items for Re-Sale Conditions of Acceptance of Second-hand Goods for Sale

Second-hand items are only accepted for resale at the discretion of the Clothing Pool management. Acceptance is subject to the following conditions:

1. Goods will be held on behalf of the owner for 2 years. After that time they will automatically be disposed of at the discretion of the Clothing Pool.
2. Commission is charged at 25% which is donated to the Parents' and Friends' Association.
3. Goods shall be current uniform items and in good order, that is: free from tears, patches, stains etc or obvious wear.
4. All items should be ready to wear by their next owner: Blazers must be dry cleaned with dry cleaning tape attached. All clothing shall be freshly laundered and ironed. Name tape removed, seams and hems sewn, buttons secured and any other details attended to.
5. Bags, boots and equipment shall be clean.
6. Tights, socks, bike pants and bathers are not accepted for resale.
7. The Clothing Pool Managers cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage occurring to articles left for sale. Every care will be taken.
